26 Days left in the School Year:

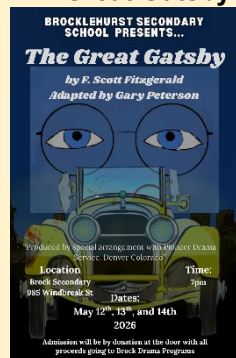
The school year is rapidly coming to an end. Students are encouraged to utilize **STRONG** Block to stay caught up on course work.
