Commencements

Commencements

- Grads enter in a procession, parade around the lower floor, take their seats
- Speeches
- Presentation of Diplomas -individual
- Valedictorian Address
- Closing Remarks and Final Hat Toss
- Grads Exit together and return to the Staging area
- Collect Items -depart -souvenir regalia -yours to keep

- Must be school appropriate and follow all School dress codes



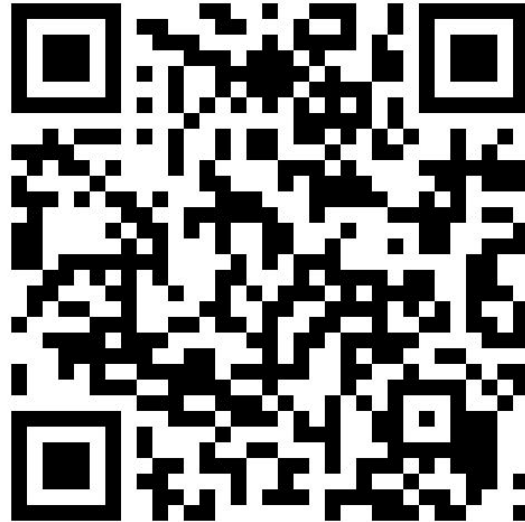
School Function
