- **Track & Field Concession / Grade 7 Fundraising**
 - Discussion regarding the Grade 7 Track & Field concession fundraiser.
 - PAC approved up to \$500 for the Grade 7 graduating class, contingent on participation by Grade 7 students and parents.
 - It was suggested that Grade 7 families support PAC initiatives, including helping with volunteer shifts for the Spring Carnival and future events.
