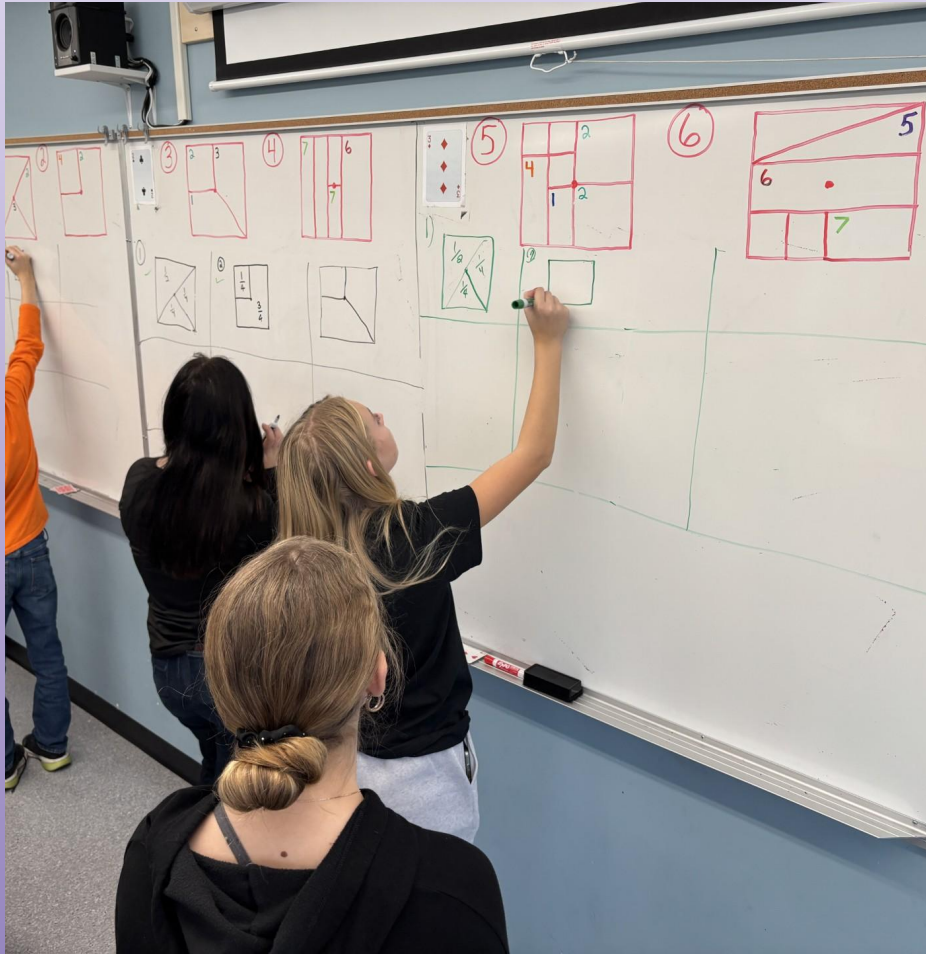

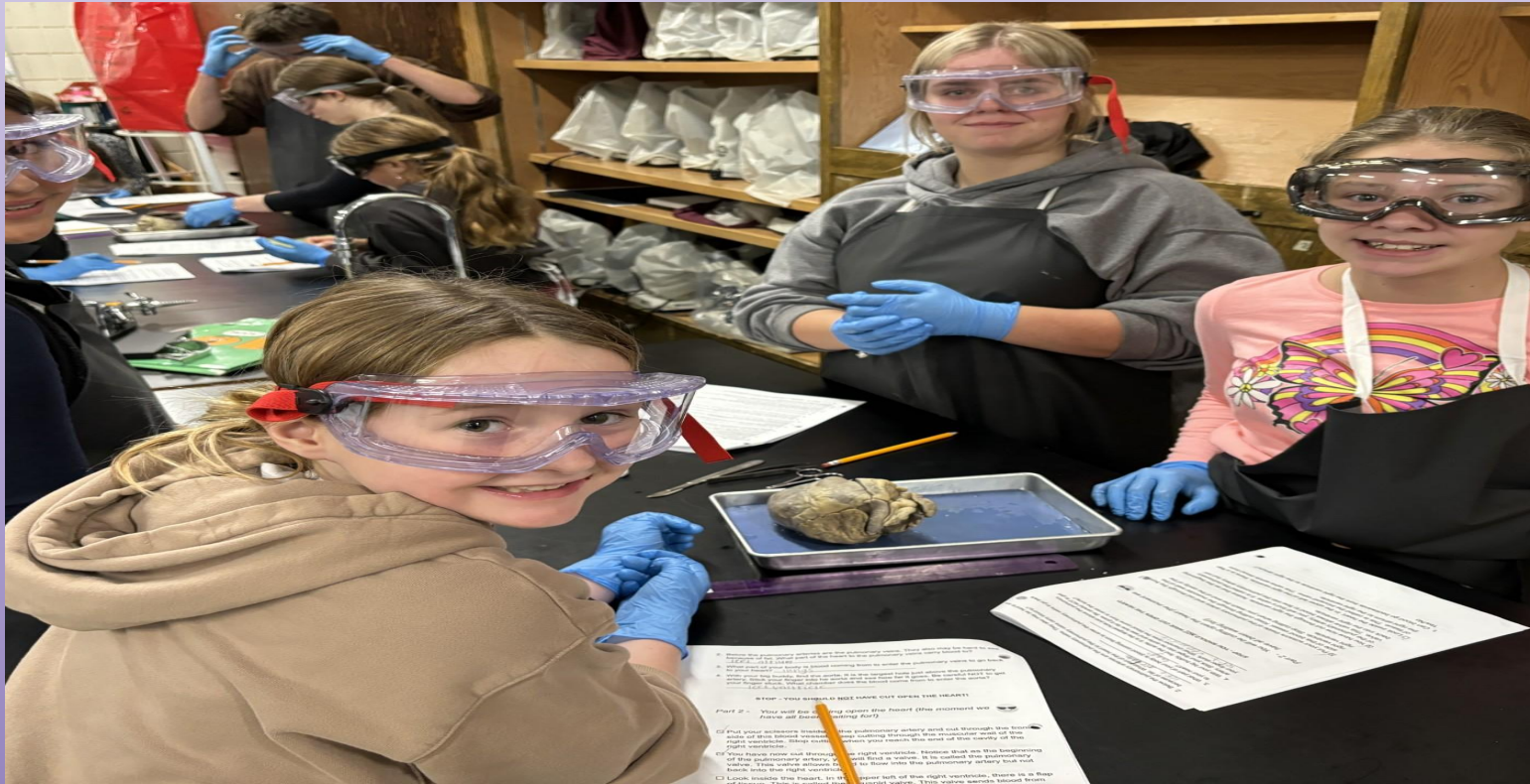

V

ALUE LEARNING

Use devices only when your teacher directs you for class activity. Focus on your studies by keeping devices off and put away unless they're part of the lesson.

I

NDIVIDUALIZED PLANS

Is it in your **Individualized Education Plan** (or ELL Annual Instruction Plan) and it is being used for an educational or learning purpose? Talk to your teacher then you're good to go!

K

EEP DEVICES SAFE

You're responsible if your device gets lost or broken. You need to store your device securely because the school isn't responsible for the phone if you choose not to secure it appropriately.

E

NGAGE RESPECTFULLY

By silencing your devices and keeping it out of sight during instructional time to help everyone focus. This includes **hallways, washrooms, and any other space** on school grounds.

S

TAY FOCUSED

We value a distraction-free environment (i.e. classroom, hallways , etc) to help everyone learn better. Keep devices put away to help you and your classmates stay focused during instructional time.

A few more things to help open the door to other options...

- Need at least 16 credits (4 courses) at grade 12 level including English 12 and Career 12
- Need 4 credits (1 course) of Fine Arts and/or Applied Skills in grades 10, 11 **or** 12
