### New Items:

- Primary Playground update: Lloyd George is in the top 5 in the district to be replaced, so it should be replaced in the next 2-3 years. The school district applies for the Playground Enhancement Program grant when replacing school playgrounds. We will have more discussions regarding layout and design closer to the announcement of a replacement date.
- City of Kamloops has asked PAC to discuss the Community Block Watch Program. It is believed that the Sagebrush Neighbourhood Association already has a Block Watch Program.
