- Chair Piroddi apologizes to the parents that took hours of their evening to attend the October 2025 AGM meeting.
- Motion to restore the 2024-2025 Executive until the new executive is elected, 1st.Linda, 2nd.Andrea, **PASSED**
- Motion to have no voting from here on forward at this meeting, until the Executive can meet and agree on how to proceed, 1st.Linda, 2nd.Rachel, **PASSED**

- Observation of October 2025 minutes, no discussion.

### **Treasurer's Report:**

- Meiling presented the October 2025 bank account transactions.

### **Fundraising Report:**

- Art Cards will be back to students at the beginning of December.
- Winter Greenery and Purdy's will arrive beginning of December, we will send an email with exact date.
- PRIVATO Vineyard & Winery Fundraiser runs November 23-December 21. Please see emails and school bulletin boards for our poster with all the details.

### **Administration Report-Melanie Dumas and Hayley Hurren:**

- Learning Updates (Report Cards) will be published December 12, 2025.
- Winter Concerts update:
  - Grade 6 and 7 Band Concert will be held @6:30pm on Dec.10 for all parents and family members, and 1:15pm for students and staff.
  - Grade K-5 Winter Concert is December 16. Afternoon performance @1:15pm, and evening performance @6:00pm; please refer to School emails for tickets.
- School Spirit Day last week was Western themed. Next Spirit Days will be the week leading up to Winter Break.
- 8 new student lead clubs will be advertised this week. Clubs will run every Tuesday during the 2nd half of the lunch hour.
- Remembrance Day assembly was great. Big thank you to the grade 7 students, Mme. Jenkin, Mme. Ramunno, and Mr. Hogeveen, it was very much appreciated.
- Volleyball is winding down, and Basketball will begin after the winter break.
- Ongoing call for lunchtime supervisors, pay is \$12/day, please fill out a criminal background check ahead of time.

### **New/Tabled Items:**

- Andrea presented the primary playground update. Linda, Andrea, and Admins met with district groundskeeper Quinton to discuss details.
  - No Provincial funding over the past 3 years, and not optimistic there will be any provincial funding grants available in the near future. PAC will be responsible for funding a new playground.
  - Our current playground is still safe, but there is an ongoing request for more swings.
  - The process going forward will be vision and budget, a catalogue will be provided by Quinton.
  - It would go to tender, then negotiation, then contracts would need to be chosen, and then finally installation. We would save 20-30% on installation if we use district groundkeepers to install.

- Costs: swings \$7000, ground gravel \$15-20,000, play structure \$60-70,000. These prices include the district installation fee.
- After purchasing the equipment, it is noted that Lloyd George would still be 3rd or 4th on the installation list at this time.
- Admin will look into the possibility of sponsor donations.
- Draft 'Terms of Reference for the Lloyd George PAC Constitution and Bylaws' was shared with the meeting participants, and will be posted to the Lloyd George website and email list. All Lloyd George parents are welcome to join the Bylaw Review Committee, headed by Elwira Rosiak.
