Please note that we cannot always get to phone calls in a timely manner, especially in the afternoon. If you need to communicate changes in plans, it is best to do so through the agenda.



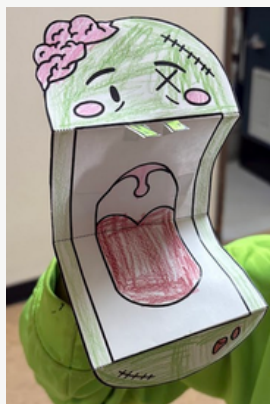


Halloween Fun
