

Logan Lake Graduating Scholarship Guidelines

General

The LLES/LLESS PAC is awarding a \$500.00 scholarship to a graduating student in the LLSS who has demonstrated community and school services and involvement while maintaining good grades. The PAC scholarship recognizes that, while at LLSS, many students achieve and are awarded for their academic success, other types of success often do not receive as much recognition. The purpose of the PAC scholarship is to reward a student who, in addition to a reasonable level of academic success, has excelled in other subject areas or has contributed to the LLSS school and/or community in a meaningful way.

Eligibility

All graduating LLSS students who have attended LLES and/or LLSS for at least 2 years and will be starting their post-secondary studies within one year of graduation are eligible to apply.

Students who have been accepted to the welding trailer are also welcome to apply towards their post secondary fees.

Qualifications

Weighting 35%

Involvement in the school community through participation on teams, in clubs, school activities or performing community services.

Weighting 30%

Active in the community at large through participation on teams, in clubs, volunteering regular attendance.

Weighting 35%

Academic effort and achievement through maintaining a minimum C+ average and consistent regular attendance. Students with an IE (Insufficient Evidence of Learning) are ineligible to receive this Scholarship.

How to Apply

Submit your application form with supporting documents to the school office by the deadline, which will be May 8, 2026.

Selection

The PAC Scholarship Committee will review and select one recipient from all applications submitted.

Only the recipient will receive notification on graduation day from the school administration.

Date of Submission

The PAC Scholarship committee must receive your application for review no later than May 8th. Submit completed applications to the office in an envelope addressed to the PAC Scholarship Committee.

2. School & Community Participation & Services (attach)

One Page Essay – outlining your achievement and any additional information you feel would assist the selection committee when they consider your application. Include your participation (and an estimate of hours spent) in the school, the community, and any volunteer activities and services performed by you during your school years in Logan Lake. Don't discount any activities you are doing or have done that demonstrate your involvement.

3. Supporting Documents (attach)

- a) A letter from the School Leader, endorsing your application and relating to the content and extent of your volunteerism and participation.
- b) A letter from a Community Leader, endorsing your application and relating to the content and extent of your volunteerism and participation.
- c) Copy of the most recent Transcripts of Marks and proof of post-secondary education enrollment.
